He trained at Kelham Theological College and, since his ordination in Southwell Minster in 1965, has served the whole of his ministry in Nottinghamshire. He became Canon of Southwell Minster in 1986. A keen sportsman, Alan follows both Nottingham Football Clubs and is a former member of Nottinghamshire Cricket Club's General committee.

Over the past 32 years Alan has donated over £100,000 to various churches, charities and sporting organisations by means of his speaking fees. His charm, warm-heartedness, funny true to life stories are infectious and highly entertaining.
